

CERTIFICATE IV AND STATEMENT OF ATTAINMENT IN MENTAL HEALTH WORK (NON-CLINICAL)

TAFE NSW has two courses available to meet the needs of employees in mental health support work. The courses are for people who are already working in the community services and health area and who want to expand their skills in mental health support work, or who are considering work in the mental health area.

The Certificate IV course is a nationally endorsed qualification. It may take up to two years part time but current workers can apply for advanced standing or recognition. The Statement of Attainment course consists of specific modules (or units of competence) from the Certificate IV. You will be able to select modules (units of competence) that meet your specific training needs in mental health support, prevention and community education strategies. The programs are taught by current, qualified and experienced workers in the field. The courses build on programs that have been successfully implemented by Newcastle and Ourimbah TAFE Colleges.

Fees \$750 per year, or \$375 per semester for Certificate IV; \$300 per year or \$150 per semester for the Statement of Attainment
