Eligibility

This course is suitable for new and existing managers in community services including frontline supervisors, team leaders, program managers and coordinators.

Participants must have the opportunity to supervise staff throughout the program.

Completion pathways

- 1 New managers or managers 'acting-up' in a management role with less than 2 years experience
 - 12 month program
 - Total of 10 days face to face training and workplace based activities
- 2 For experienced managers with 2 or more years experience
 - 6 month "Express" program
 - Total of 8 days face to face training and workplace based activities

Costs

Due to a new government incentive, funding may be available for this course equating to a saving of over \$3,000, reducing fees to \$764 per person for the 6 month course and \$1528 per person for the 12 month course. *Applicants may also be eligible to apply for a scholarship.
